# Economic activity and social change in the UK, real-time indicators: 24 October 2024

Early data on the UK economy and society. These faster indicators are created using rapid response surveys, novel data sources and innovative methods. These are official statistics in development.

# 1. Main points

- Overall retail footfall in the week to 20 October 2024 decreased by 1% when compared with the previous week but was 2% higher than the equivalent week of 2023 (MRI OnLocation).
- The annual growth rate in average automotive fuel prices remained broadly unchanged when compared with the previous week but decreased by 8 percentage points when compared with the equivalent week of 2023 (Department for Energy Security and Net Zero (DESNZ)).
- The total number of online job adverts on 18 October 2024 decreased by 3% from the level in the previous week and was 18% below the equivalent period of 2023 (Adzuna).
- Approximately one in seven (15%) trading businesses reported that their turnover had increased in September 2024 compared with August 2024, broadly stable with the previous month; in contrast, almost one in four (24%) reported that their turnover had decreased from August 2024, with 22% citing economic uncertainty as a challenge (final results from Wave 118 of the Business Insights and Conditions Survey).
- The System Average Price (SAP) of gas remained broadly unchanged in the week to 20 October 2024 when compared with the previous week, while the System Price of electricity increased by 16%; when compared with the equivalent week of 2023, the SAP of gas decreased by 14% and the System Price of electricity decreased by 19% (National Gas Transmission, Elexon).
- The daily average number of UK flights in the week to 20 October 2024 decreased by 2% when compared with the previous week but was 2% higher than the equivalent week of 2023 (EUROCONTROL).
- The total number of Energy Building Performance Certificates (EPCs) for new dwellings across England and Wales in the week to 20 October 2024 was 3% lower when compared with the equivalent period of 2023 (Ministry of Housing, Communities and Local Government).

These are <u>official statistics in development</u>, and we advise caution when using the data. The data sources used to compile these indicators are regularly reviewed to ensure they are representative and relevant, which may mean indicators change at short notice. #### Notes

- 1. Card spending over time is pushed upwards by the impacts of both inflation on value of transactions and cash-to-card conversion.
- 2. Revolut adjustments to user count are at an aggregate level and as such age bands may not adjust evenly.
- 3. Indicators with SA in the title have been seasonally adjusted.

# 4. Glossary

## **Real-time indicator**

A real-time indicator provides insights into economic activity using close-to-real-time big data, administrative data sources, rapid response surveys or experimental estimates, which represent useful economic and social concepts.

## Seasonal adjustment

Seasonal adjustment is the identification and removal of consistent and systematic variation in time series associated with the time of year. ## Official statistics in development

The data presented in this bulletin are reviewed and refreshed on a regular basis. Indicators are swapped in and out of the publication based on their suitability and availability.

## Seasonality

Seasonal fluctuations are likely to be present in many of these indicators, so caution must be applied when interpreting changes in series that are not seasonally adjusted.
